

## vsNEW - Victoria Symphony New Explorations Workshops 2022-23

vsNEW is an innovative program in which young, local composers write new works for a small ensemble of dedicated Victoria Symphony Musicians. 2022-23 is the 17th year vsNEW has been a part of the VS Education programs.

This year vsNEW is led by Composer-Mentor Rodney Sharman and an ensemble of VS musicians. In each workshop, the composers bring their pieces in various stages of completion and they are read through by the musicians. We then have a period of feedback from everyone in the room and the composers voice their opinions about their own works and take suggestions from the musicians and others. From the most basic to the most complex, many musical issues arise and it is a great learning experience for all of us.

In addition to sessions with the musicians of the ensemble, private lessons with the Composer-Mentor will be arranged in person or online after the first meeting.

The Victoria Symphony is proud of this program's success and many young composers have won local, provincial and even national awards through it.

## Requirements for student participation:

- 1. You currently study on a regular basis with a music teacher who can oversee the writing process to ensure progress between workshops (not necessarily a composition teacher).
- **2.** Age range 10-18 (Middle School to High School)
- **3.** Some prior composing experience either a solo instrument work or a piece with multiple instruments. This year participants will work on writing for a small string ensemble.
- 4. The ability to properly notate and have experience writing your own music. The workshop musicians will be reading directly from the student's scores/ parts. <u>Students will be expected to bring sufficient copies for each musician and for everyone in the workshop to see. Photocopying may be done in the Victoria Symphony office. Unfortunately, we do not have access to the copiers during the sessions.</u>
- 5. Participation at all workshops is required, except in the case of emergencies or sickness.
