
#### Sean O'Loughlin

#### Conductor

Sean O'Loughlin (b.1972) is the Principal Pops Conductor of the Victoria Symphony, as well as Symphoria in Syracuse, NY. As a composer and arranger, his music is characterized by vibrant rhythms, passionate melodies, and colorful scoring. Commissions from the Boston Pops Orchestra, the Los Angeles Philharmonic and the Hollywood Bowl Orchestra highlight and showcase his diverse musical abilities. As a conductor, he has led performances with the Boston Pops Orchestra, the San Francisco Symphony, the Chicago Symphony, the Hollywood Bowl Orchestra, the Vancouver Symphony, and the Seattle Symphony, amongst others.

He has served as conductor for international tours with Josh Groban, Sarah McLachlan and the Jerry Garcia Symphonic Celebration. Other recent collaborations include such artists as Adele, Pentatonix, Kelly Clarkson, Jason Mraz, Melissa Etheridge, Janelle Monáe, Audra McDonald, Diana Krall, Itzhak Perlman, Natalie Merchant, Chris Isaak, Pink Martini, Brandi Carlile, The Decemberists and others.

She has performed as a soloist and/or concertmaster on television shows such as *The Grammy* Awards, American Idol, The Voice, The Tonight Show, The American Music Awards, The Ellen Show, The Latin Grammy Awards, X Factor, Rising Star and Home for the Holidays. Her lengthy list of television credits also includes The Academy Awards, The Emmy Awards, Dancing with the Stars, Family Guy and the Star Trek series, to name a few.
