Marcelline is passionately involved in developing programmes which involve children with the arts community, and in integrating music education and the performing arts. She has been Music Education consultant with the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra for 20 years, preparing students for listening to the symphony, and training school students for live movement performances with the orchestra. She now works as Education consultant with the Victoria Symphony.
